Citizens Advisory Committee

Purpose: To advise the Pioneer School District 402 Board of Directors on matters pertaining to the operation, functionality, facilities, and educational programs within the school district.

*The advisory committee will be assigned projects or tasks by the Board with the expectation that those advisory members will represent the community and provide feedback to the Board when asked.

*Members of the committee will be representative of the Pioneer School District community. The Board will strive to appoint members who represent a variety of views and experiences.

*Training will be provided to appointed members that will emphasize how to work as a committee and how to organize tasks and assignments.

*Any meeting of the Citizens Advisory Committee will fall under the Open Public Meetings Act.

*The committee will select a chair and vice-chair as well as a member to take minutes/notes of each meeting. The chair and vice-chair will develop meeting agendas. The agenda for meetings will be sent to each school board member prior to the meeting.

*Meetings of the Citizens Advisory Committee will be scheduled as needed.

*The school board will place on the agenda room for the advisory committee to make monthly reports.
